Some Facts About Cancer

- Cancer is not a communicable disease. It is not contagious. You cannot “catch it” the way you catch a cold or the flu.
- Childhood cancer, or pediatric cancer, is rarely inherited. (Some cancers, like breast cancer, do have genetic implications.)
- Personal habits, like smoking cigarettes, do contribute to the cause of cancer.
- Cancer can occur in the blood, nerves, bone, and tissue.
- Cancer is not an automatic death sentence. Many if not most children recover from cancer.
