Some Side Effects of Cancer Treatments, Procedures and Medications

- Hair Loss
- Weight loss or gain
- Change in physical appearance because of surgery (amputations, facial surgery) or as a result of weight loss during chemotherapy
- Lethargy
- Weakness
- Nausea
- Loss of appetite
- Change in personality or demeanor
